



## BROWARD COUNTY USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION

By-Laws – Approved by Broward County USBC Bowling Association Board for the Hall of Fame  
Effective December 1, 2011

- The Hall of Fame shall be divided into two (2) categories
  1. Bowling Ability
  2. Meritorious Service
  
- 1. Nomination(s) for the Hall of Fame will be accepted from anyone before February 1 of each year. If a category is not indicated on the Hall of Fame application, the Screening Committee (made up of Non Hall of Fame members and past Hall of Fame members) will decide which category would be appropriate. The Screening Committee would submit the selection to the Broward County Bowling Association for approval, with the understanding that a person could be nominated in both categories. All information on the application will be verified by the Screening Committee using records from local association, bowl.com and any other sources available to confirmation of information submitted. The Committee will decide on inclusion or exclusion of the nominee(s) name(s) to be placed on the ballot.
  
- 2. Names of the applicants and all information about the nominee(s) accomplishments will be included in the package sent by U.S. mail to all live Hall of Famers by March 1, of each year. The nominees address, phone numbers or date of birth will be removed from the application.
  
- 3. Ballots received blank will not be considered.
  
- 4. The completed application MUST be returned to the Association office to be eligible for consideration by February 1 of each year. The Chairperson will compile the resumes and distribute them, on or before March 1, to the Screening Committee.
  
- 5. Mail in ballots must be postmarked by April 1 in order to be accepted. Ballots may also be dropped at the Broward County Bowling Association office by April 1.
  
- 6. Voting shall be on a one (1) ballot system (all nominees on one ballot). All nominee(s) must receive 2/3 of all votes/ballots returned to be deemed elected to the Hall of Fame. Voters may vote yes or no for any or all nominees on their ballot. Rule #6 will be printed on each ballot for clarity.
  
- 7. The ballot provided shall contain nominee(s) grouped according to the category under which the nominee is seeking election.
  
- 8. The ballot provided shall contain nominee(s) grouped according to the category under which the nominee is seeking election in.

## **A – Bowling Ability Criteria**

- 1) The Nominee will be judged on their bowling ability while a member of the Broward County USBC Bowling Association. **Junior bowling activities will not be considered.**
- 2) The Nominee must have been active in the Broward County area for a minimum of ten (10) years.
- 3) The Nominee must be considered on his/her individual achievements in **Broward County only.**
- 4) The Nominee must have participated in a minimum of five (5) Broward County Bowling Association County tournaments.

## **B - Meritorious Service Criteria**

- 1) The nomination will be based upon Meritorious Service provided in **Broward County only.**
- 2) The Nominee must have been active in the Broward County area for a minimum of ten (10) years.
- 3) The Nominee shall be of good ethical character and shall have demonstrated commitment to the sport of bowling.
- 4) While service to our sport is appreciated, this honor is intended to include those who provide **EXCEPTIONAL**, not merely participatory service and, likewise, excludes service provided by owners and employees of bowling establishments who contribute only as part of their employment. Exceptional and innovative service, above and beyond mere participation or employment, is the basis for this award.

\*\*\*\* The nominee must have remained in good standing with the USBC throughout their career. Any nominee who has been suspended for malfeasance in office, misappropriation of league/association or tournament funds, not paying league fees or behavioral suspensions shall be deemed ineligible for inclusions in the Hall of Fame under any category.

\*\*\*\*If a Hall of Fame member is suspended by the governing body of our sport, the Hall of Fame members may decide on that members' removal from the Broward County Hall of Fame. Once removed a member may not be re-instated. This will be done by vote of the living Hall of Fame members. In order to remove a Hall of Fame member it will require ½ (one half) of the ballots returned agreeing to remove the member. Blank ballots will not be counted.

**AWARD(S):** Inductee will be acknowledged as suggest by the Broward County Bowling Association either at league, county tournament or at the Annual Association meeting. Someone from the HOF Screening Committee or BCUSBC Bowling Association will present a plaque to the inductee.
