



## BROWARD COUNTY USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION

**2010** By-Laws – Approved by the Hall of Fame October 1, 2008

The Hall of Fame shall be divided into two (2) categories

1. Bowling Ability
  2. Meritorious Service
1. Nomination for the Hall of Fame will be accepted from anyone before February 1 of each year. If a category is not indicated on the Hall of Fame application, the Committee will decide which category would be appropriate, with the understanding that a person could be nominated in both Ability and Service. All accomplishments must be verified. All personal information will be removed prior to mailing. Resumes will be lettered alphabetically and ballots cast by alphabetical letter. At the completion of the ballot count any applications not chosen for the Hall of Fame will be destroyed. Persons not elected may re-submit an application next year. Ballots received blank will not be considered.
  2. The completed application **MUST** be returned to the Association office to be eligible for consideration. The Chairperson will compile the resumes and distribute them, on or before March 1, to the current members of the Hall of Fame.
  3. Mail in ballots will be accepted by Hall of Fame members who have elected to participate. The ballot must be postmarked by April 1 in order to be accepted.
  4. Voting shall be on a one (1) ballot system (all applicants on one ballot). If a nominee receives 50% + 1 of the votes cast, said nominee is deemed to be elected. Hall of Fame members may vote for more than one person.
  5. The ballot provided shall contain nominee(s) grouped according to the category under which each is seeking election.
  6. **BOWLING ABILITY CRITERIA:**
    - 1) The Nominee will be judged on his/her bowling ability while a member of the Broward County USBC Bowling Association. Junior bowling activities will not be considered.
    - 2) The Nominee must have been active in the Broward County area for a minimum of ten (10) years.
    - 3) The Nominee must be considered on his/her individual achievements in **Broward County only.**
    - 4) The Nominee must have participated in a minimum of five (5) local association County tournaments.
  7. **BOWLING SERVICE CRITERIA:**
    - 1) The nomination will be based upon Meritorious Service provided in **Broward County only.**
    - 2) The Nominee must have been active in the Broward County area for a minimum of ten (10) years.
    - 3) The Nominee shall be of good ethical character and shall have demonstrated commitment to the sport of bowling.

- 4) While service to our sport is appreciated, this honor is intended to include those who provide exceptional, not merely participatory service and, likewise, excludes service provided by owners and employees of bowling establishments who contribute only as part of their employment. Exceptional and innovative service, above and beyond mere participation or employment, is the basis for this award.
  
8. If a Hall of Fame member is suspended by the governing body of the Sport of Bowling, the Hall of Members may decide on the removal from the Broward County Hall of Fame. Once removed you may not be reinstated.

**AWARD(S):** Inductee will be invited to the Annual Dinner Dance to receive his/her award.
